Joint Event of Science with international participation '**River Basin and Flood Risk Management 2015 and Hydrological Days 2015**' is therefore prepared with the

involvement of all relevant water management organizations and bodies and has an ambition to present effective solutions.

The conference '**Hydrological Days**' organized alternately by the Slovak Committee for Hydrology and the Czech National Committee for Hydrology in regular 5 year intervals has had its tradition since 1980. The conference was organized in Slovakia in the following places: Zemplínska Šírava (1985), Stará Lesná (1995) and Bratislava (2005). The events were always prepared in close cooperation with top hydrological and water management institutes in Slovakia and the Czech Republic. The conference '**River Basin and Flood Risk Management**' is held every two years, and the organizers believe that after four previous conferences focused on the relevant topic, this Joint Event of Science will also contribute to the tradition of respectable, competent and systematic approach to the issues affecting the whole society.

4. Hydrological extremes: modelling and forecasting

Hydrological days 2015

1. Role of hydrology in sustainable management of water resources
2. Hydroecological aspects of water resources assessment and utilization
3. Experimental hydrology and new methods in water status monitoring and assessment
4. Hydrological extremes: regime and its changes

Important deadlines:

29 May 2015: submission of the title and abstract of a paper – 10 lines maximum

19 June 2015: informing authors about receiving the abstracts of papers and sending out the instructions for conference papers

17 August 2015: submission of papers for the electronic conference proceedings

18 September 2015: sending the completed application forms

Conference Languages:

English, Slovak, Czech, Polish, Hungarian, simultaneous interpretation will be provided
